

There Is A Generation...

What does it mean to live in our times, having been touched by God's spirit and understanding what God requires of us? There is a generation, whose teeth are as swords, and their jaw teeth as knives, to devour the poor from off the earth, and the needy from among men.

(Pro 30:11-14)

This is indeed an accursed Generation described above. What better verse to describe the generation of Americans that has vomited forth onto its once pristine lands. Now I am not here to say all Americans are like that, there are many *quite notable* exceptions and often times, perhaps more often than not, the really good folks make no Christian profession. They run homless shelters, help the mentally disabled, assist the handicapped and have decided to give in this life rather than receive. Yet, I look at the number of abortions in America, the coldness so many have in this nation to the poor and the needy and the arrogance of the people and the nation as a whole. It pains me to see these things. But what is worse I think is that most Americans do not see themselves that way. They will run to the abortion clinic, have their baby literally sliced into pieces and call themselves 'good'.

I see the constant drone of war in America, who in her supreme arrogance wants to blow up parts of the planet who don't agree with their models of governance. Everywhere we turn America has dropped bombs, engaged in Special Operations against the poor, or even to start wars so that one side can blame another for something that the US did in secret, hoping for war. Even today its major corporations are behind throwing people off of their lands in far off places. But America is not the only one. We sing 'God bless America' and then fall down before satan and do all that he asks. Jesus may be on many of our lips, but most of America's hands are

dedicated to the devils work.

Then we can see that in America how the poor are vilified and mocked. The wickedness against the poor is very great in this nation. I am not just talking about our war against 'poverty' in Afghanistan and Yemen, where we have taken to killing just about anyone who is dirt poor who dares to take up arms to end the constant cycle of violence against the poor of their nations and the corruption that is often overlooked if not encouraged by America. No I don't need to go very far at all to see how the Rich and Powerful nation of America treats poor people. America's cruelty against homeless people is well documented, right here against fellow Americans.

In October of 2004, three Milwaukee teens murdered a homeless man at his forest campsite. The teens hit 49-year-old Rex Baum, with rocks, a flashlight, and a pipe, before smearing feces on his face and covering his body with leaves and plastic. According to the criminal report, one of the boys "hit the victim one last time to see if he would make a sound like in Grand Theft Auto," and then cut him several times with a knife to make sure he was dead.

In August, Curtis Gordon Adams, 33, beat and stabbed a disabled homeless man to death, and then licked the blood from his fingers on a Denver sidewalk.

In June, two New York City teens, kicked, punched, and finally bludgeoned 51-year-old William Pearson to death in a churchyard. Pearson crawled to the church steps before finally dying of a fractured skull. "His head was a bloody mess," one police officer noted.

Sadly, these gruesome accounts are few of many, which demonstrate the hate / violence faced by people experiencing homelessness each year. The following report documents 105 hate crimes and violent acts that occurred in 2004, collected from newspapers and reports across the country. The narratives bring to light the discrimination and senseless violence faced daily by so many of our country's homeless citizens. - National Coalition For The Homeless

Yet the realities are far different. The real America is made up of Americans and any intelligent (foreign) person who has a 10 minute conversation with most Americans comes away with serious questions about how such base ignorance and cruelty could possibly reside within one human being all at the same time. As Hugo Chavez before the UN said, 'you can smell the sulfur'. Because when it all boils down to it, many Americans just don't care about anything but their own bank account. They will cheat any soul, lie and tell themselves any lie (self deceit) to get more money. They like to make noble noises, but in many lurks the spirit of

larceny, greed and a hardness to the less fortunate. America has a epidemic. A serious one that cannot be cured by vaccines or pills.

Americans Growing Epidemic Of Violence

Over the past twelve years (1999-2010), advocates and homeless shelter workers from around the country have seen an alarming, nationwide sustained increase in reports of homeless men, women and even children being killed, beaten, and harassed. In response to these concerns, the National Coalition for the Homeless has produced twelve reports documenting these acts, the newest report entitled Hate Crimes against the Homeless: Violence Hidden in Plain View. Our reports are collected from a variety of sources including media and advocacy reports. However, it is important to mention the numbers of crimes collected in our reports are estimated to be a gross under-representation of the actual number of incidents due to lack of reporting to police, victims. - Hate Crime Organizing Manual National Coalition for the Homeless
