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Judge Not

...lest Ye Be Judged

Brothers, when we point out other individuals shortcomings and mock them and try and put ourselves above them we commit a grave sin. Did you know that even Christ was called a sinner by those who claimed to be religious? Oh yes, he was called demon possessed, a drunkard, a partier because he eat and drank with those people the religious establishment did not like. Oh yes, he was constantly mocked and called names.

*Whereunto then shall I liken the men of this generation? and to what are they like? They are like unto children sitting in the marketplace, and calling one to another, and saying, We have piped unto you, and ye have not danced; we have mourned to you, and ye have not wept. For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and ye say, He hath a devil. **The Son of man is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners!** But wisdom is justified of all her children.*

(Luke 7:31-35)

It was one of those things where in the eyes of the religious phoney's it was '*darned if you do and darned if you don't*'. The pseudo religious hypocrites were looking to the outside and judging Christ by their own satanic self-serving judgment standards, long on finger pointing, short on introspection.

*Therefore **thou art inexcusable**, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein **thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself**; for thou that judgest doest the same things. But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things. And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?*

(Romans 2:1ff)

I have long learned walking many decades with God that you just don't do that. Do you want to point the finger at the fact that this guy or gal who may be withdrawn or depressed and that they are 'no fun' anymore? Do you want to point the finger at another who you may observe is perhaps not themselves, these days? Have you walked a mile in someone else's shoes? Did it occur to you that that person may be at some kind of breaking point? You want to blast that Priest who may be drinking more than he should? Did it occur to you that he may have seen something or knows something that has deeply troubled him (maybe a pedophile cover up in his parish or church funds being misused)? Priests are people too, so are pastors. Before you judge, maybe you would do better to sit down and talk to *him as*

a friend or better yet, pray for him. That guy who may be behaving erratically lately, short tempered and then you... you talking about him like a dog. Did it occur to you that they may have a kid at home that requires expensive medical care and that they just lost their job and don't know how they are going to pay for it? Did it occur to you that they may have come home a few weeks ago and found their spouse in bed with another person? Did it ever occur to you that maybe they are having a hard time dealing with their own medical condition and that they are having a real hard time dealing with the fact that the Doctor just gave him 6 months to live? Or maybe just got a notice on their front door that the bank is going to sell their house due to foreclosure? Hey, you try and rent an apartment with the bad credit that goes with foreclosure.

Let me tell you all something. I have learned **the hard way** not to judge other individuals. Now I will grant you, there are some things that you cannot explain away in this manner (like divorce without the cause of adultery, murder, stealing when one has enough already, etc) But for the most part, I have found that many folks are having a hard time adjusting to conditions in their own lives you may not be privy to. It's why I am not hard on those who abuse drugs. Some peoples lives are very difficult and at times are unbearable. I am not excusing it, but I do understand it. Mercy is needed here, not judgment. It's why, while I must speak out against the trends in Sodomy in our nation (it is my duty as a watchman) I will not spit hate at gay people. It's a terrible sin yes, but you know what? So is divorce (except in the case of adultery). You don't know what kinds of trauma people have had in their childhoods (given mixed signals about sexuality or may have been molested, etc). What I know is that God **demand**s that such things be given up to come to Christ but we Christians must learn to be merciful, caring *and* forgiving. **Less judgment and more love** is what is truly needed. Listen, from a purely secular perspective and seeing the way Marriage and divorce are handled in our society the cold calculating viciousness of so many marriage partners, the greed of the lawyers, the personal agendas of some of the Judges when dealing with divorce... the greed, the bitterness the hate... one can better understand why so many men turn to homosexuality... and I say that having NO homosexual tendencies or experiences. Not to digress too much here, but if you want to know the truth, I think a lot of Gay's are more reticent about the whole issue of Gay marriage than the corporate/elitists/population-control **funded** Homosexual rights front organizations will ever be allowed to be let into the mainstream. Most gays are not interested in offending others, 'making a social statement', getting alimony, or anything other than being left alone! They do not want their private sexuality being made into a public issue.

A Lesson

Many years ago, I worked with a guy who was nothing more that 100% grade triple A 'a--hole'. I think you know the type. It was only after a couple of years of observing this guy's maliciousness that I began to ask some questions about him. It turned out that he was always an orphan and had been handed off from orphanage to orphanage from the time he was born. He never knew the love of a parent or the stability of a home. I cannot say that was an excuse for his behavior but I can say that it did explain a great many things.

The Lord gently rebuked me and it taught me a valuable lesson. You do not have all the facts about *anyone's* life. Certainly not enough to judge them AS INDIVIDUALS. Arrogance and **ONLY arrogance** will lead you to do that and pride (a key satanic trait, let the reader understand); putting yourself and your own **lost and reprobate mind** on some kind of self appointed pedestal. You who judge another person, have you preached the gospel to them? Have YOU told them of God's love and

forgiveness? Who are you, O arrogant one, to pass judgment on another person who may be going through some personal hell you are not privy to? Has God given you the keys to hell and death? Has he placed you on the Throne of Christ **who alone** shall judge the living and the dead? Who do you think you are? Does God have to demonstrate to you *personally* exactly who and what you are? Ask that king Nebuchadnezzar, he thought he was 'hot stuff' too in his arrogance. God had the guy go nuts and eat grass for seven years in the fields like a wild beast. This was in the days before insane asylums were created.

This is one of the main reasons why I have been so adamant about our global assassination, murder, and terror campaign across the globe. You have this last-days end time empire that is totally under the control of occultists, big money and the devil, drawing up death lists for people they have never met and are never going to meet. You have what on the surface may seem like good people going out and doing the killing, the bombing, the kidnapping the assassinating, the torturing, **passing judgment** on those they haven't never known or met and have not had a right to be heard.

No trial, no justice, no hearing no nothing and perhaps a very large campaign gratuity to get someones name on the list that who may be innocent of any crime **and many are**. I can only say to you who decry terrorists, do you blow up things and kill innocent people? You who hate those who support terrorism? Do you cheer at the deaths of innocent people murdered in our drone attacks, killing men women and children? You who are you quick to judge another man's murder, when was the last time you looked at your own blood-soaked hands dear American voter, politician, national security professional or military member? You think terrorists belong in hellfire? Perhaps they do but where does that leave you, *ye who commit the very same acts*? By the way, please wrap your hands up in a towel please before you come in, those bloodstains dripping down from your fingers are real hard to get out of the carpet.

I have learned not to judge individuals. I have learned not to judge others who claim to be Christian, but before I will believe that they are truly in the family of God, I will find out where they are at. Recently, I was shocked to hear someone I have long respected say that Muslims and Christians worship the same God and then turn around and say that Israel (Jews in Israel) are not God's people. Well, as the Lord has shown me time and again, sooner or later, the truth will out and usually out of the persons own lips.

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

(Acts 4:12)

Well, Allah is not Jesus Christ and the Koran is not the Bible and the trail of bombings, murders, church burnings, humble Christians being beaten, raped, run out of their homes by Muslims should tell anyone with a working brain that there are some serious differences between the God of Islam and the Lord and Saviour, Christ Jesus. A **real** (an exceedingly small number in the west) born again Christian believes that there is **only one name** whereby men may be saved and that name is Jesus Christ, not Allah. The testimony of Christ, the bloodline that produced him, and even the time of his arrival were meticulously placed into the scriptures so that mankind would not be lost wholesale and so that anyone who really wanted to know could find out that God is the God of time and knows the end from the beginning. God sent his OWN SON down here to save us and subjected him to death, even the death of the cross to *demonstrate his deep love for mankind, yes even in our wicked and sinful state.*

*For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins. As concerning the gospel, they are enemies for your sakes: but as touching the election, they are beloved for the fathers' sakes. **For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.** For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief: Even so have these also now not believed, that through your mercy they also may obtain mercy. For God hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all. - Romans 11:25ff*

Israel is still God's people, but AFTER THE FLESH. They are still spiritually dead, having to this day rejected the Messiah, the wellspring of life. But **God has not forgotten them** and has some very important works to do with them, he brought them back out of the lands where he had driven them... for 2000 years. He kept his promise. He did not do this for Israel sake but for his own sake.

*And when they entered unto the heathen, whither they went, they profaned my holy name, when they said to them, These are the people of the LORD, and are gone forth out of his land. **But I had pity for mine holy name,** which the house of Israel had profaned among the heathen, whither they went. Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; **I do not this for your sakes, O house of Israel,** but for mine holy name's sake, which ye have profaned among the heathen, whither ye went. (Eze 36:22-23)*

*Then shall ye remember your own evil ways, and your doings that were not good, and shall loathe yourselves in your own sight for your iniquities and for your abominations. **Not for your sakes do I this,** saith the Lord GOD, be it known unto you: **be ashamed and confounded for your own ways, O house of Israel.***
(Eze 36:31-32)

*Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, **a remnant shall be saved**: For he will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth. And as Esaias said before, Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrhah.*

(Rom 9:27-29)

*Behold, I have refined thee, but not with silver; **I have chosen thee in the furnace of affliction. For mine own sake, even for mine own sake, will I do it**: for how should my name be polluted? and I will not give my glory unto another.*

(Isa 48:10-11)

Most Jews in Israel will not be saved. The Scriptures bear witness to that fact. They also bear witness that even after the Flesh, they are still are God's people and shall be judged even as his people. It is a perennial mistake those who DO NOT KNOW THEIR BIBLES make to not fully understand the role Israel plays in our times. You want to tell me there are sinners in Israel? That they mistreat Palestinians, that they engage in assassinations, that they torture people, that they have major organized crime rackets taking over the nation? Well that describes mosts of the nations on earth as well, like say... America. Such people they do not know their Bibles and they certainly **do not believe God** (unbelief/rebellion) because Israel's place is stated clearly for anyone who takes the time to read it. In short they have placed their own subjective morality above God's plan AND MERCY. In their arrogance they say, *'I know better than God, these people are sinners, they are not God's people.'*

If I had to sum up what Paul is saying here in these chapters it would be this. You gentiles who now have the gift of salvation, God will still have mercy on Israel, it is **his to give** and give it to whomever HE (not you) chooses. You who want to judge God's plan of salvation and whom he should forgive, backtalking God?

Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to him that formed it, Why hast thou made me thus? Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

(Rom 9:20-21)

That passage was written specifically regarding Israel's place and God's sovereignty in choosing whom will serve him. So hear this, ye mockers, don't get arrogant or proud... look at Israel. Look what happened to them. Don't gloat. Israel, at least part of her, will be restored even after this rank and multi-generational apostasy. **You**, on the other hand, have no such promise given to you from the prophets of old. If God did not spare the natural Branches from tribulation and damnation (Israel), **neither will he spare you**. You want to point the finger at their sins? From what were you forgiven and who forgave you? If they are not doing right, you leave that to God, he has a plan that he has not fully revealed to us Gentiles. Rather than spitting hatred at Israel, why not try **really** praying for them and the peace of Jerusalem? Brother, you let God decide on whom he will have mercy. You want to point out their sins? And into what bloodline of sinless perfection did you say you were born into, O perfect accuser?

*Therefore hath **he mercy on whom he will have mercy, and whom he will he hardeneth**. Thou wilt say then unto me, Why doth he yet find fault? For who hath resisted his will? (Romans 9:18)*

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every

one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

(Rom 1:16)

Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile. But glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile

(Rom 2:9-10)

If Israel's behavior especially in security matters is extreme, so is the history of persecution against Jews and so is the hatred of so many who surround her, to this day who chant 'death to Israel'. She has tasted the poison of genocidal maniacs and means it when she says 'Never Again'. This does not excuse so many of the truly evil things she does but *they are better understood in that light*. I know of no nation or people (save the true remnant of God) who will not take **extreme measures to protect themselves**, their families and their children. But today in modern satanic thought, it is OK for everyone else to rape, kill, torture, assassinate, terrorist-bomb for "national security's" sake, just not the Jews. That thinking comes right out of the pit of hell (see Revelation 12:1-6; 12:17). It says, 'persecute the Jews and curse them for defending themselves the same way we do.'

I think many a Muslim will one day be saved. Yes I do, but ONLY when they come to Christ. I read about how many Muslims turn to Christ from a pamphlet, a movie, a preacher or even from dreams and visions of Christ and I know that God is calling out people who will serve him in humility, truth and righteousness (John 4:23-24), not arrogance and pride and pointing the finger and someones else's shortcomings. You can do that when **God and God alone gives you the proper anointing**. Otherwise, brothers, let your words be few.

Be not rash with thy mouth, and let not thine heart be hasty to utter any thing before God: for God is in heaven, and thou upon earth: therefore let thy words be few.

(Ecc 5:2)

Let me leave you all with this. There are very few who are called to point out the sins of others and that rarely includes any pointing a finger at **an individual** and even if it is, it will be done face to face. Prophets are called to do it but usually it is done to a king, ruler or some person of influence to whom God has a specific message. To a lesser degree it applies to watchmen who must line up what they see with God's word and that often means some most uncomfortable and uncomplimentary observations about a group or society in general, not individual people in particular. That is a major part of their job. You think this job is easy? You don't think I would not ditch this the second Jesus released me? Let me tell you... you could measure the timeframe for me leaving this job in MILISECONDS after Christ released me. It's not that I do not find any joy in assisting others in opening their eyes, I do. It can be most rewarding. It's not that I know I haven't been trained and 'cut out' for a job like this, I know I have been. It is not that I am perfect in this job, I am not. But the Lord said "Write, warn the people of what is coming." So that is what I do. Go and read the verse from Habbakuk posted at the top of this page.

What wears on me? The nitpicking the perfectionists the lost souls who try and judge me and point the finger at me because they do not see a halo over my head, or because I drive on old car, or do not have a ethereal aura around me, or don't see a legion of angels surrounding me wherever I go. They do these things when their own lives are filled with rebellion and sin. Brothers I cannot lie to you, it gets old... real, real old. Folks have mocked me and spoken evil

about me behind my back when I tried to show deep concern for others. So know this, Mankind may not have created a chronometer that can measure time in such a small increment as the time it would take for me to leave this job when (and only when) Christ released me! I am not in love with this job and frankly have asked more than once to be released from it so that I can get the heck out of this country and go live in some quiet village on an Island or in some remote part of the earth, quietly and peacefully away from the evils and vanity of modern existence (I cannot call it life). But **I am not going anywhere** until I have been released by the Lord and I am not sure that that is going to happen on this side of the grave.

You want to see a perfect person? I am not it. There was only ONE perfect person and his name is Jesus Christ, the rest of us who are **truly** "born of the blood" Christians are sojourners *on the path* to Christlike righteousness, we will have our hangups, our troubles our shortcomings but we acknowledge them and repent of them and keep on moving. Let others split hairs and point the finger, "*See Aha!*" they rave in their accusations (*Satan's name actually means the accuser, if you didn't know*), "*I saw you drink that beer, sinner... you are going to hell!*" Yet the Bible does not forbid alcohol, just drunkenness. "*Aha, I saw you look at that woman with the pretty legs, you evil lecher!*". No one has stopped being human and I know I have not and let the person who points the finger at another look into their own soul and actions. You who accuse another who looks at a pretty woman, you said you were married... what... three times... or was that four? You will **not find perfection on this side of the Grave** and you who decry someones else's crimes, when was the last time YOU broke the law, meddling in things that are not your business doing things that others have done and wound up in prison?

My words to all of you are this, **Judge Not, lest ye be judged**. Show mercy and God will show you mercy, point the finger at another mans sins in accusation and God will surely remember yours.
